One thing that I have noticed when looking over the data for the week is that there have been a number of reports of suspicious persons and vehicles being seen in the area. This is to be encouraged and we would ask that whenever your suspicions are aroused, please do call and give as much detailed information as possible, including descriptions, behaviour, vehicle details and why you consider them suspicious. While I cannot promise that a police unit will be deployed to each report, the information is recorded and may well assist with other investigations or in gathering intelligence. Many of the suspicious person/vehicle reports do turn out to be legitimate but this information is vital to us.

Rogue Traders.

There have been reports of rogue traders in the area over recent days and I urge you not to accept that work needs to be completed on your address by someone calling at your door. The usual scenario is that they tell you there is a small amount of repair work needed and offer a cheap price. However, they then 'discover' other problems which they then charge a high price for. If someone points out work needed on your property, thank them and request a written quote (if you wish) – then get a second written quote from another contractor before deciding what, if anything, you are going to do.

Finally, please don't think that the fuel thefts and metal thefts have stopped – I'm sure they'll be back!
