This summer Hampshire Constabulary are running a campaign to reduce anti-social behaviour and help everybody enjoy the school summer holidays safely. Many children have less adult supervision during the holidays and it could be easy for them to unintentionally become involved in activities that could cause distress or annoyance to someone else. A number of young people could also put themselves in danger. We will be carrying out targeted patrols to combat anti-social behaviour. We will be confiscating alcohol from children and working with licensees to ensure that young people cannot buy alcoholic drinks.

So what is anti-social behaviour?? It is any aggressive, intimidating or destructive activity that damages or destroys another person's quality of life.

Examples include vandalism, graffiti, playing loud music, continued shouting or swearing, playing noisy or aggressive games near people's houses or littering.

People of all ages become involved in anti-social behaviour, it is certainly not just young people. However this campaign is aimed at school children because during the summer holidays they have more time on their hands! By targeting children we hope we can encourage them to change their behaviour before they grow into adults.
