Crime Prevention Advice

- If you have an alarm please set it.
- Check your security lighting is in working order
- Make it look as if your house is occupied by using a timer on a light or radio.
- Ask a neighbour to keep an eye on your house while you are away, and make sure post, deliveries etc are not left on your doorstep.
- Leave contact details and perhaps a spare key with a neighbour.
- Take care when talking about your holiday plans in public places - who is listening??
