Crime Prevention Advice

Crime prevention around your home:

- Maintain security of the premises by ensuring access to the rear of the property is secured via a locked gate and sound boundaries
- When leaving the property empty keep all windows and exterior doors locked at all times
- Garages and sheds should be locked with tools chained and padlocked together inside, with the chain secured to the fabric of this outbuilding
- Use a shed alarm as an extra way of securing sheds and garages
- Ensure security lighting is sited in such a way that it is tamperproof
- Use timer switches to ensure that your house is lit if it is unoccupied in the late afternoon or early evening
- Make a note of and report registration numbers and descriptions of any unfamiliar vehicles which appear suspicious
- Note any persons making cold calls at your home; descriptions of the individuals, their clothing and the reasons they give for calling.
