- Do a bit of pruning now to maintain good visibility round your property - it discourages burglars
- Ensure your timer switches are in good working order, replace them if necessary. Don't forget to use them to make your home look occupied when it is empty.
- Ensure your external lights are working and if possible install a motion activated exterior light.
- If you are away, ask a trusted person to brush up the autumn leaves that tend to accumulate by your front door to ensure that it appears as if people are coming and going.
- Install alarms on your sheds and outbuildings particularly if they are screened from view.
