Stockbridge Police Station Opening Times

The rural Test Valley Safer Neighbourhoods team is based at Stockbridge; however they have a responsibility for all of the rural villages. It is our job to ensure that we are accessible to members of the rural community and as such we make every effort to ensure that the majority of our time is spent out on patrol working within the community.

We have recently had a phone installed at the front of the police station which provides a direct link to the police control room. This therefore ensures that any person who visits the police station can speak to a representative from the Hampshire Constabulary if the front office is closed.

In an effort to maximise the teams patrol time I have decided not to publish set opening times of the police station, our policy is that if an officer is in the station then the front office will be open, if however you visit the station and it is closed then please use the phone provided and speak to an operator who may be able to deal with your query direct or will contact a rural officer on duty or take a specific message if required.

This policy will ensure that the rural police team are not confined to the police station and can plan their patrols accordingly.
