Natalie Klein's exceptional musicality has earned her a number of prestigious prizes including the Classical Brit Award for Young British Performer of 2005 and the Ingrid zu Solms Cultur Preis at the 2003 Kronberg Akademie Solm% Cultttt. She won the BBC Young Musician of the Year (aged 16) in 1994 and in the same year was the first ever British winner of the Eurovision Competition for Young Musicians in Warsaw. She was awarded the Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother Scholarship by the Royal College of Music before completing her studies with Heinrich Schiff in Vienna.

Fei was born in Beijing, where she was discovered by John Williams. She now lives in London. Her second CO for EMI was released last year ('40 Degrees North'). She has given two fantastic sold-out recitals at the Wigmore Hall, London over the last couple of seasons. In addition to the Wigmore, her recent recitals have included The Sage Gateshead, St Georges Bristol, Turner Sims Southampton, Philharmonic Berlin, Laeishalle Hamburg, Esplanade Singapore and Concertgebouw Amsterdam. The programme will include works by Manuel de Falla, Villa Lobos, Bach and Larcher.
