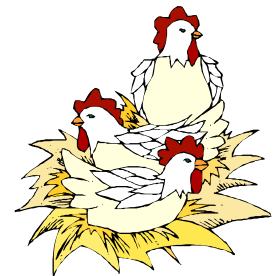
# Woolton Hill Village Market
